Instructions for video presentation

All registered participants are expected to prepare and upload a pre-recorded video describing their poster presentation. The pre-recorded videos will be available to all participants during the Conference in the virtual platform.

As the organizers would like to leave space to open creativity, there are no special requests other than technical instructions.

Please note that the file of your presentation must be a video file in MP4 format and the duration of the presentation should be strictly no longer than 2 minutes and maximal size of 20 Mb.

Video presentation should be in HD quality and optimized for web.

It is recommended that your pre-recorded presentation includes a window box with the speaking presenter via a webcam, instead of a voice-over presentation only.

There are several video conferencing tools available to easily record a presentation. Everybody is free to use software of her/his choice.

Tips for Recording:

- Use a place for recording as quiet as possible.
- Avoid areas that have echo or bad acoustics.
- Put a good microphone close to mouth. Avoid, if possible, using default built-in microphone on computer.
- Remember to speak slowly and enunciate clearly, without pausing.
- Make sure you have good front light – ensuring that the light shines brightly on your face. If your back is to a window, close the shades.
- Put the camera at eye level.
- Do a test recording of a couple of minutes and review the sound and picture quality before recording the entire presentation. Make adjustments if needed.
- Upload your video in the mp4 format (Deadline: 15 May 2021)
- **Please note, that you have to be registered to Euromar 2021 conference, with paid fee, before you are able to upload your video presentation.**
